

Cineseeds Ambassador PowerPoint Guide

You can use this guide when you present your PowerPoint to the class.

- **Slide 1.** Introduce yourself! You're the Ambassador for the Human Rights and Arts Film Festival. Your mission is to promote human rights awareness through film for kids.
- **Slide 2.** Describe what Cineseeds is, and how Cineseeds aims to inspire and educate children through film.
- **Slide 3.** Ask the class or assembly "What do you think human rights means?"
- **Slide 4.** Explain how human rights are a basic set of rights that everyone is entitled to. They are rights based on everyone having freedom, respect and dignity.
- **Slide 5.** All the countries of the United Nations agreed upon these rights. The rights are listed in a very important document called the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.
- **Slide 6.** Read the slide.
- **Slide 7.** Describe what human rights include- you may want to add other human rights!
- **Slide 8.** Describe how human rights affect everyone, including people from poor and wealthy countries, from all ethnicities and backgrounds.
- **Slide 9.** Read the slide; explain that Cineseeds attempts to draw attention to both positive and negative stories.
- **Slide 10.** Read the facts on the slide- you may want to add some more!
- **Slide 11.** Read the slide. Explain that there are positives and negative stories about Indigenous rights.
- **Slide 12.** Read the facts on the slide. You may want to add some more!
- **Slide 13, 14 and 15.** Read the slide, adding extra information where you see necessary (look at the notes under the slides for more ideas).
- **Slide 16.** For JUNIOR Cineseeds only (if Senior skip/delete this slide)
- **Slide 17.** For SENIOR Cineseeds only (if Junior skip/delete this slide)
